Although we didn't receive priorities for January-March 2022, the below priorities are Police generated from intelligence and reports received by the Police and also states how we have been addressing them:

**PRIORITY 1 – ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR – targeted patrols have been carried out in ASB hotspots offering an increased Police presence. We have also engaged with individuals that have been identified as acting anti-socially and educated them on the impact their behaviour may be having on the community.**

**PRIORITY 2 – OTHER TRAFFIC OFFENCES – Educating drivers in regards to parking, patrolling high collision routes and offering words of advice to drivers in regards to the manner of their driving as well as targeting drivers not wearing seatbelts and using mobile phones.**

**PRIORITY 3 – SPEEDING – SNT have been continuing speed enforcement across locations that have been reported as a concern by local residents with words of advice and fixed penalty notices being issued where appropriate.**

Please can you also inform me of what if any action the parish council has taken in relation to the above priorities so that we can update our priorities tracker? We are keen to promote a joint effort in reducing harm in our communities.
